

## Twenty-Fourth Sunday of the Year

### The lost coin

#### INTRODUCTION

Have you ever lost something which is very important or precious, perhaps a favorite book or a particular toy? Today Jesus reminds us that God knows and loves each one of us, and will search until he finds us if we should lose our way.

#### SIGN OF THE CROSS

#### LIGHT THE CANDLES

Sing the Candle Song.

#### SORRY

If we do something wrong and wander away from God's love, he is always ready to forgive us and lead us back to him. Listen to this story Jesus told:

One day a shepherd found that one of his flock was missing, so he left the other ninety-nine sheep, and went off to look for it. He searched and searched until he found it, because every one of his sheep was precious to him.

(Matthew 18:12-14)

If we have not been good and have lost our way, let us ask Jesus to forgive us and to lead us back to his flock.

#### GOSPEL (LUKE 15:1-3, 8-10)

After overhearing the Pharisees complaining about him spending so much time with tax collectors and sinners, Jesus told a parable: "Once there was a woman who had ten silver coins. One day, as she counted her savings, she realized that one of the precious coins was missing!

"The woman was poor, and to lose even one small coin made her very sad. So she lit her lamp and looked under all the furniture. She swept every corner of the house and searched until final-

ly she found it! Picking up the coin she ran to tell all her friends the good news."

Then Jesus said, "God will search for anyone who is lost, and rejoice when he finds him or her."

#### DISCUSSION

The Pharisees were very proud of their "goodness" and their obedience of the law. They would not associate with people they considered to be sinners, and yet Jesus welcomed sinners! All too often for the Pharisees, Jesus was to be found spending his time with "sinners," instead of with people like themselves.

What happened in the parable which Jesus told? (Encourage the children to retell the story in their own words.)

The coin was very precious to the woman, and even though she could not find it at first, she carried on looking until her efforts were rewarded. In the same way, God our father will search for anyone who has wandered from his love because each one of us is precious to him.

Jesus came to forgive the sinners who had lost their way, and welcome them back to God's love. How did the woman react when she found what she had lost? Her sadness turned to joy, and she ran to share the good news with her friends.

When we sin and turn away from God's love, he is filled with sadness. This sadness turns to joy when we change our ways and come back to our heavenly father.

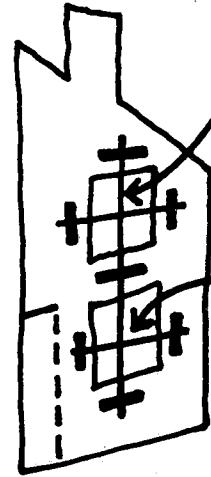
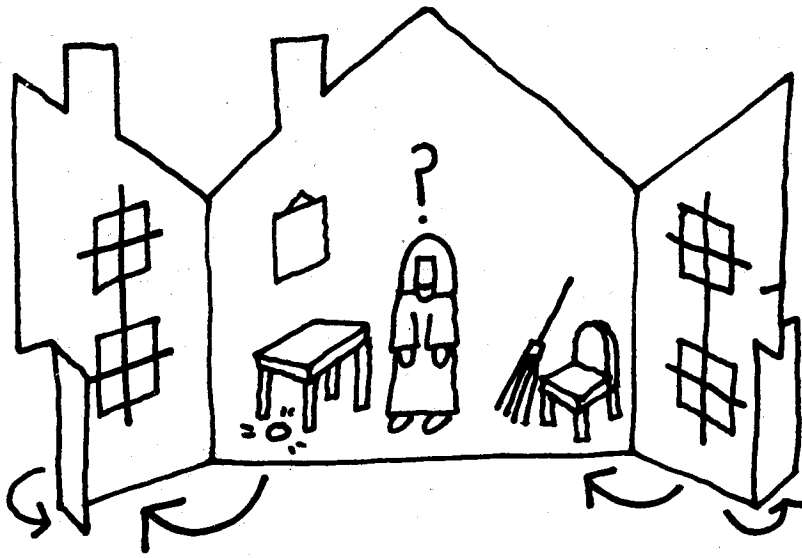
#### ACTIVITY

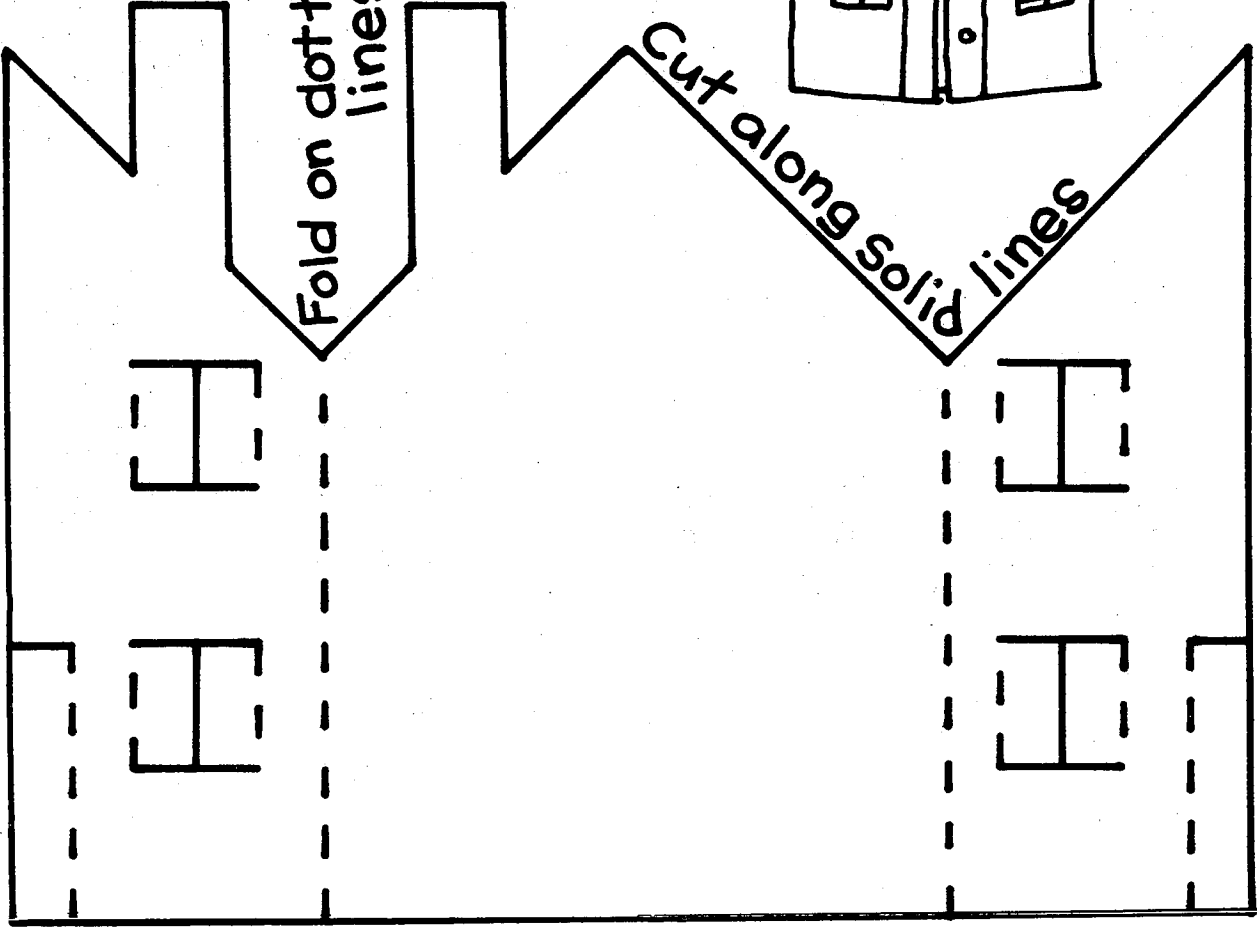
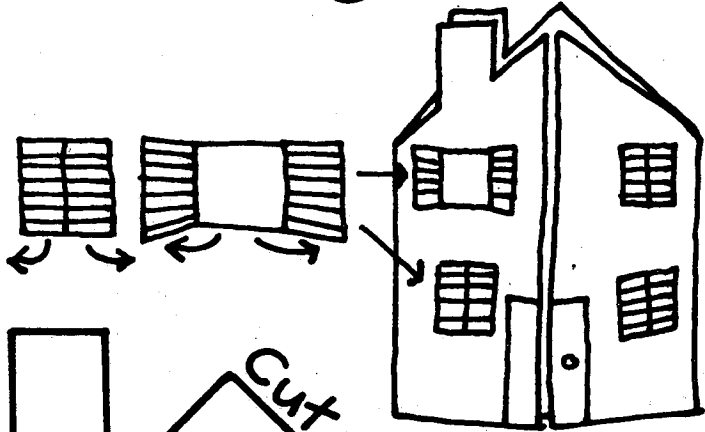
#### CREED
