INTRODUCTION

All of us know how good it feels to get away once in a while from the hustle and bustle of our everyday lives, and enjoy some peace and quiet. Jesus gave us the gift of his peace which comes from God himself.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

To welcome today's Gospel sing Acclamation 5.

GOSPEL (JOHN 14:23-27)

Jesus said: "If you love me, my father will love you and the Holy Spirit will live in your hearts and fill you with wisdom and goodness. I leave you the gift of my peace, a peace which comes from God alone. Remember, do not be afraid, because I will be with you always."

DISCUSSION

Jesus gave the gift of peace to his followers. What

does the word "peace" mean? It means to be calm and quiet and free from disturbance or trouble.

What was special about the peace which Jesus shared with his disciples? The peace which Jesus shared was the special feeling which comes from being filled with the spirit of his love and goodness. Being close to God gives us a wonderful feeling of well-being and happiness. Jesus offered this peace to anyone who chose to follow him.

Stop and think for a few moments: Which part of your normal day is most peaceful and quiet? (Encourage the children to share their thoughts and ideas.)

For many people, the most peaceful time of day is at bedtime, just before they fall asleep. It is a good time to think about everything that has happened that day and to spend a little time talking to God.

Why is it important to make time for peace and quiet in our lives? Many people find it easier to pray and feel close to God when they can sit quietly without noise and distraction. At such moments, we can talk to God and he can speak to us in our hearts. Then we know the peace which Jesus promised us, as we are filled with the spirit of God.
